

## 2016 MATRIC RESULTS

Once again, we are delighted by the successes of our matriculants. We congratulate the Class of 2016 on their outstanding results and, in particular, we celebrate the achievement of **Uzayr Jadwat**, who was placed on the **IEB List of Outstanding Achievers Countrywide** (the list of the top 5% of candidates in 6 subjects, who also scored 80% or more for Life Orientation). Our candidates have maintained Clifton's 100% pass rate (compared to the IEB rate of 98.67% for 2016), have achieved a 97.94% Bachelor Degree pass rate (compared to the IEB rate of 87.61% for 2016) and are all able to pursue tertiary studies in 2017 and beyond.
